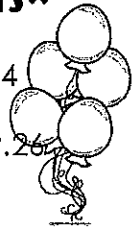
WELCOME TO PRESCHOOL!

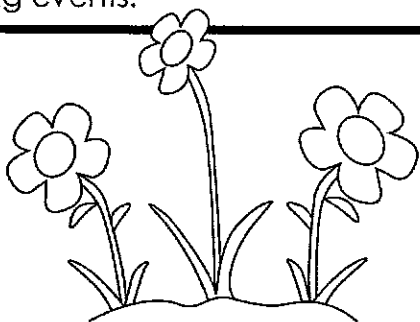
*Feel free to post to one another, ask questions, and share pictures from classroom functions!
