



Quick Notes for Parents

JCEC is a little to no-cost opportunity for students and families.

Early College is the fifth year of a high school/college educational plan.

Students participate in graduation and graduation activities.

Students receive their high school diploma upon exit from the Early College program.

Students must take a math or math-related course as part of the Early College classes.

Students enroll in Jackson County Early College and earn an Associate's degree, a certification, or up to 60 transferable college credits.

Students attend most, if not all, of their classes at a Jackson College Campus, although some classes could be offered in local districts or on-line.

Early College students may participate in high school athletics through their 12th year, but may not participate in athletics at their district or at Jackson College during the 13th year.
