#### #1: Make a Learning Decision

<b>Option 1: Remote Learning</b>	<b>Option 2: In-Person Learning</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- For remote learners, the primary delivery platforms for Young 5's - 2nd grade is SeeSaw and Google Classroom for grades 3rd-5th.</li> <li>-Students are expected to work remotely for a time period that is appropriate for their age.</li> <li>- Students will remotely complete assessments, assignments, activities, and/or practice items as they complete subject area learning.</li> <li>- Learning packets will be available for those students that lack online access. Learning packets will be delivered via bus on Wednesdays and Fridays.</li> <li>-Staff will conduct personal connections with all remote learners via email, telephone, or remotely.</li> <li>-Staff will grade assignments once they have been returned or submitted online.</li> <li>-The remote teacher will provide students with “office hours” that will be used for homework help and questions.</li> <li>-Daily attendance will be taken.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Daily face-to-face instruction provided by the teacher.</li> <li>-Students will be welcomed at Ezra Eby Elementary five days per week.</li> <li>-Eby will continue our daily schedule as closely as possible to the way it has always operated.</li> <li>-Our students will still receive the benefit of physical education, music, and technology classes.</li> <li>-All students will be eating breakfast and lunch in their classrooms. Breakfast and hot lunches will be delivered by our Food Service Staff. Students may bring their own lunch from home.</li> <li>-MASKS are REQUIRED:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*on buses</li> <li>*in hallways</li> <li>*transitions outside of the classroom</li> <li>*on the playground</li> </ul> </li> <li>-MASKS are NOT REQUIRED:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*in the classrooms</li> <li>*while eating/drinking</li> </ul> </li> <li>-Daily attendance will be taken.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ There is a two week grace period if you are not sure which option is right for your child. This allows for a parent to change the mode of instruction if you feel it is not the best option for your child.</li> <li>★ 9 week Commitment-once you have chosen an option, it best serves the student and school to stay with that option for a full quarter or 9 week period.</li> </ul>	

Student Drop-off/Pick-up	Bussing
<p>-Students will be required to bring a screening slip (provided by the school district) from their parent(s)/guardian(s) signifying the student is COVID-19 symptom free and able to attend school.</p> <p>-If a student does not have a screening slip with them, staff will take the student’s temperature prior to them entering the building.</p> <p>-Parent(s)/guardian(s) must wait for their child to be screened prior to leaving the premises if they did not bring a screening slip.</p> <p>-All students that are brought to school <b>must enter through the front main door of Ezra Eby.</b></p>	<p>-When getting on the bus, students will be required to bring a screening slip (provided by the school district) from their parent(s)/guardian(s) signifying the student is COVID-19 symptom free and able to attend school.</p> <p>-If a student does not have a screening slip with them, the bus driver will take the student’s temperature prior to them getting on the bus.[.</p> <p>-Parent(s)/guardian(s) must wait for their child to be screened prior to leaving the bus stop if they did not get on the bus with a screening slip.</p> <p>-All students riding the bus will enter the building from the courtyard, North parking lot.</p>
