For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS.

Napoleon High School continues to focus on reading comprehension strategies as well as core algebra standards. Additionally, we have continually added to our social-emotional learning and support. These endeavors have made clear that Executive Functioning Skills has been in a deficit post-pandemic. We continue to work those skills into predominantly 9th & 10th grade core courses.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. Students are assigned to Napoleon High School based on being passed/promoted from 8th grade or based on graduation progress from transfer transcripts.
2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN continues to be refined and monitored, focusing on reading, math, social-emotional learning, and Executive Functioning Skills.
3. We do not have a specialized school within NHS.
4. The Core Curriculum is based on Michigan Merit Curriculum Standards and can be accessed by written request within the principal's office.
